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## Keyholes

This puzzle's clues are numbered according to their answers' rows or columns, in order within each row or column. A certain number of squares must be skipped (left vacant) in order for answers to fit in the diagram. These "holes" should be marked as such with circles. When all clue answers have been placed in the diagram, the solver should be able to insert a "key" letter into each hole such that a new word or phrase is created either across or down. There may be some ambiguity, but those solvers who insert all the right keys will be rewarded with a final Key Word, reading left to right, column by column. There are five capitalized answers.
